Contracts or bill of sales are not accepted as ownership for amateur owner and junior owner classes.

## ENTRY FORM MUST . . .

—be signed by the exhibitor, rider, driver, handler, coach (if applicable) and trainer. In the case of a rider under the age of 18, his/her parent or guardian must sign on the minor's behalf. All entries must have the trainer line signed, as that is the adult person who has care and custody of the horse at the show.

—show the address, phone number and email of owner and trainer.

—include all current USEF and AHA membership numbers for each owner, trainer, rider, handler, lessee, agent and coach.

—include registration numbers and description of all horses.

## INCLUDE WITH YOUR ENTRY. . .

—copy of registration papers for each horse, including contract or bill of sale if horse is not in exhibitor's name. (Horses being purchased may only be shown under new owner's name if a copy of the contract is included.)

## AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT

Each owner, trainer, rider, driver, handler and coach must be an AHA Competition Level member or pay a Single Event Membership of \$35 per person. Riders in only walk/trot classes and leadline are exempt from this requirement. The parent or guardian signing on the minor's behalf also is exempt. Memberships may be purchased online at [www.ArabianHorses.org](http://www.ArabianHorses.org), and a membership card printed at that time.

## USEF MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENT

Each owner, trainer, rider, driver, handler and coach must be an USEF Competing Equestrian member or pay a Non Member Fee of \$30 per person. Riders in only walk/trot classes and leadline are exempt from this requirement. The parent or guardian signing on the minor's behalf also is exempt. Memberships may be purchased online at [www.USEF.org](http://www.USEF.org), and a membership card printed at that time.

## USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

USEF life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements or this rule; 1) Leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF Introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes. 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

# GENERAL INFORMATION

**EVERY CLASS** offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Exhibitors are urged to become members of the USEF so as to familiarize themselves with the rules. Questions not covered by USEF Rules shall be decided by the Show Committee and its decisions will be final.

EXCESSIVE USE OF THE WHIP ON ANY HORSE IN A STALL, RUNWAY, SCHOOLING AREA, SHOW RING, OR ELSEWHERE ON THE COMPETITION GROUNDS BEFORE OR DURING A SHOW, BY ANY PERSON, CONSTITUTES A VIOLATION AND RENDERS THE OFFENDER SUBJECT TO PENALTY. JUDGES WILL BE EXPECTED TO ENFORCE THIS IN THE ARENA.

**RESPONSIBILITY** – All entries are accepted with the understanding that The Arabian & Half Arabian Club of Oregon, Inc. and their employees will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed, or in any way injured. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify The Arabian & Half Arabian Club of Oregon, Inc. against any and all loss damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs; including attorney fees which may be incurred as a result thereof. Exhibitors, grooms, handlers, owners, etc. are hereby warned that they may not use any device or conduct which may cause harm to any other person(s), horses, or equipment. THE SUBMITTING OF ANY ENTRY FORM TO THE SECRETARY SHALL CONSTITUTE AN ACCEPTANCE BY EACH PERSON SIGNING SAME OF THE PROVISIONS HEREIN SET FORTH.

**ADMISSION TO THE RING** – No person will be allowed in the ring except participants in the class, judges, assistants, and show photographer. Attendants will be allowed in the ring only after being called by the judge, ringmaster or announcer. All attendants should be properly attired.

**ARENAS** – Competition arena: 100' x 200'. Warm-up arena: 100' x 300'. Covered outdoor arena: 100' x 240'. All footing is mixed sand/dirt/shavings.

**ARRIVAL INFORMATION** – Stabling is available at noon on Thursday, May 20 through Sunday, May 23. Stall use before or after this time will be charged an additional daily fee of \$20. **Earlier arrivals need to clear their arrival time and confirm stall assignments with the show manager no later than May 10.** Please do not move into stalls without confirming stall assignments. Exhibitors occupying incorrect stalls may be charged for cleaning services and/or additional bedding.

## AMATEUR DEFINITIONS

AAOTR – Adult Amateur Owner to Ride

AOTR – Amateur Owner to Ride (any age)

ATH – Amateur to Handle (any age)

ATR – Amateur to Ride (any age)

AATR – Adult Amateur to Ride

AOTD – Amateur Owner to Drive (any age)

*Riders, drivers and handlers 18 and over (as of Dec. 1, 2009), must have USEF amateur certification to show in amateur classes.*

JOTR – Junior Owner to Ride

JTR – Junior to Ride

*Riders in junior to ride classes are considered amateurs, and do not need amateur certification. Juniors must not have reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday by Dec. 1, 2009.*

**AMATEUR STATUS** – Adults competing in classes for amateurs must possess a 2010 Amateur Certification issued by the USEF. There is no charge to USEF competition members. Non members pay \$30 for amateur certification.

## AWARDS

Awards to first, ribbons first through sixth.

Championships and medal classes: awards to first, ribbons through eighth

\$100 prize money: 1<sup>st</sup> \$40, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$30; 3<sup>rd</sup> \$20; 4<sup>th</sup> \$10

Prize money may be picked up in the show office. Unclaimed prize money will not be mailed.

**CLASS CALLS:** First call occurs when horses two classes ahead enter the ring. Second call occurs when the preceding class enters the ring. Third call is while ribbons are being awarded in the preceding class. To prevent delays, the two-minute rule after the first horse enters the ring will be enforced. There will be no changes in the class schedule. If you foresee a class conflict or have a tack change, please notify the paddock person. We appreciate your cooperation.

**CANCELLATION OR DIVISION OF CLASSES** – The show committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide classes or make schedule changes necessary for betterment of the show. All such changes will be announced. Any regular performance class of more than 30 horses will be split and shown in the regular schedule as duplicate sequential classes with duplicate awards. Any performance championship that reaches 30 entries will be shown as a semifinal class with horses selected by the judge for final competition. Driving and walk trot classes will be divided at the discretion of the show committee to permit maximum safety.

**CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES** – Horses must have been entered, shown, and judged in the appropriate qualifying classes as specified in the prize list in order to be eligible to show in the championships. In the halter, champion and reserve in each section will be selected from the first and second place winners in the classes for horses 3 years old and older. The junior champion and reserve in each section will be selected from the first and second place winners in the classes for horses 2 years old and under. Should any first or second place winner that is qualified to compete for halter championship elect not to compete, no other horse may be substituted.

**DISCIPLINE** – Exhibitors are advised that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider or member of the family of the person participating in the show, will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a horse or the offending person from the show without being liable for compensation of damages.

**DOGS** – Dogs will NOT be allowed in the grandstand area. Dogs in any other area of the facility must be on a leash or confined.

**JUDGES** – In the event a judge fails to attend the show or to perform his duties, the show committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is designated in the premium list. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision unless he first obtains permission from the show committee or steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place.

**MOTORIZED VEHICLES** – In accordance with GR1301.7, minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may

operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**PROTEST** – Protests may be filed as set forth in USEF GR 602.

**REFUNDS:** With vet certificate, if presented no later than 9:00 PM May 20, 2010. \$20 office fee will be retained

**REFUSAL OF ENTRY** – AHACO Arabian Show reserves the right to refuse any entry if it is in the best interest of the horse show. THE AHACO Board of Directors has directed that entries must be refused from anyone that has an outstanding obligation to AHACO.

**RETURNED CHECKS** – Checks returned by the bank for any reason will incur a fee of \$40 per check. No checks will be processed through the bank a second time. To retain entries, fees plus penalty must be paid by money order, cashier's check or cash prior to 5 p.m. Thursday, May 20, 2010. In the event a check is returned by the bank after the completion of the show, it will be handled in accordance with USEF GR913.

**RV SPACES** – Full hookups are available for \$100 for the duration (+\$30 early arrival). Hookups with electricity only are \$60 (+\$20 early arrival). **Note:** If you sleep in your rig – even though not hooked up – the cost is \$60 as the facility will charge the show.

**STABLING** – Stabling consists of permanent box stalls with top and bottom doors. There is a charge of \$25 per stall for any exhibitor using bedding other than shavings. Tack rooms must be left clean or a \$10 fee will be assessed by the facility. There is an additional fee of \$25 per stall for any exhibitor excessively filling their stalls (at management discretion).

**AHA SADDLE SEAT EQUITATION MEDAL CLASS** - Open to riders who have not yet reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to December 1. Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Tests 1-15. Markers shall not be used. Class 178.

**AHA REINING SEAT EQUITATION MEDAL CLASS** - Open to riders who have not yet reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to December 1. All contestants are required to perform a reining pattern outlined in UEF Reining. Dropping of bits is optional with the judge, but if called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials. Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits. In an AHA Reining Seat Medal, an off pattern rider is eliminated and eligible to win a medal or ribbon. Class 210.

**AHA HUNTER SEAT NOT TO JUMP MEDAL CLASS:** Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to December 1. Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from AHA Article 1336.9. Class 154.

**AHA WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP MEDAL CLASS:** Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday prior to December 1. Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform a minimum of four tests from USEF AR224. Class 187.

**WALK-TROT:** Open to riders 10 years and under, riding a purebred Arabian or Half Arabian mare or gelding. English or Western, no Side Saddle. To enter the ring at a walk to the right. To be shown at a walk, jog trot if Western, trot if English, both ways of the ring. To be judged on attitude, manners, performance and suitability of horse to rider, quality and conformation. No post entry fee. Class #144 (Western Pleasure), Class #135 (Hunter Equitation), #180 (Saddle Seat Equitation), Class #177 (Western Equitation), Class #240 (Hunter Pleasure), #242 (Country/English Pleasure), Class #52 (Trail Horse).

**LEADLINE:** Open to riders at least 2 years of age but have not reached their seventh birthday as of Dec. 1. Leaders must be at least 14 years. Stallions prohibited. Saddle must fit the rider. Rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups/irons. Leading rein must be attached to a cavesson or halter placed under or over the bridle. Boots required. Entries to show both directions of the ring at a walk, to line up on command and stand quietly. Rider may not cross enter other classes. No post entry fee. Class #186.

1. **General Provisions**

To be held at the Region 4 Championship Show. Rules to be reviewed annually by the futurity committee. All rules not covered by this document will be governed by the current rules of the USEF. Entries will show and be judged under applicable class specifications for junior horses as set forth in the Arabian division of the USEF rule book. Region 4 Futurity Committee may modify horse's age requirement. Reining classes to be video taped

2. **Tack & appointments**

Western horses to show in bosal or snaffle bit. A snaffle is defined as a center jointed single, rounded, unwrapped, smooth mouthpiece of 3/8" to 3/4" diameter metal as measured from the ring to 1" in from the ring with a gradual decrease to the center of the snaffle. Rings may be from 2" to 4" outside diameter, of the loose type, eggbut, dee or center mounted without cheeks. Riders may use both hands. Hunter pleasure horses to show in standard snaffle bits defined above, except full or half cheeks are allowed. Bits will be inspected.

3. **Eligibility**

All entries must be registered with Arabian Horse Association. There is no requirement for Owners State of residence. Western pleasure and hunter pleasure horses to be 3 or 4 years of age. Reining horses and AOTR Western Pleasure horses 5 years and under. Nominees must have never been shown in a bridle. Bridle is defined as any bit with a solid bar mouthpiece or one that has a shank (exception: Reining horses – Arabian/HA/AA).

4. **Nominations and fees**

Nominations must be received on or before the dates listed. Nominations may be transferred upon sale of a nominated horse. The futurity secretary must receive notice of sale within 30 days from date of sale. Total futurity payments, if made on due dates are \$300 per futurity class. Horses may enter more than one class. Late entry fee penalties are \$50 for missing first payment (\$350 total), \$150 for missing 2<sup>nd</sup> payment (\$450 total). Entries made after the closing of entries for the show, and up to class time will be \$500. All Class fees, stall, drug & miscellaneous fees are payable to the show. There will be no vet-outs, refunds or substitutions. **To avoid late payment charges, all payments must be postmarked by payment date schedule.**

5. **Purses & awards**

All money received from nominations will be allocated for prize money. Payments credited toward specific class entered. Prize money divided: 5 or more entries: champion 45%, reserve 22%, remainder top 5 11% each. 4 entries champion 50%, Reserve 25% remaining entries 12.5%. 3 entries champion 55%, reserve 30% remainder 15%. Regional Awards made to an unrated top five followed by champion & reserve. A full top five placing will be given even if eight or fewer compete.

6. **Declaration of Classes**

It is recommended but not necessary to declare a class with payments. **You may not change classes after your entries have been processed by the show secretary.**

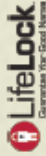
